Purpose:	To efficiently and effectively manage the Australian Surf Boat Teams in the lead up and for the duration of the Trans-Tasman Surf Boat Test Series held on Saturday 15 th February 2020 at Mollymook Beach, NSW.

➤ **Australian Surf Boat Team Manager key responsibilities:**

- To build and implement a campaign plan in conjunction with SLSA staff for the Trans-Tasman Surf Boat Test Series. The campaign plan may include but not limited to:
 - Travel
 - Athlete Insurance
 - Outfitting
 - Athlete logistics
 - Catering
 - Safety
 - Culture
 - Equipment – Sourcing Suitable boats for New Zealand Crews
- Contribute to the Australian Surf Boat Team and Development Team culture and identity which fosters pride, mateship, passion and performance.
- Ensuring that the Australian Surf Boat Team and Development Team has the ideal environment for athletic performance in the lead up and during competition.
- Maintain a high standard of integrity and behaviour from the Australian Surf Boat Team and adhere to and implement organisational and team codes of conduct.
- Report any breaches of organisational and team codes of conduct during camps/training/competition to the SLSA Sport Manager in accordance with SLSA processes.
- Attend the various selection events.
- Be available for all briefings with SLSA.
- Maintain a consistent and high level of communication with event organisers and key officials including management of official team protests in competition.
- Assess and manage risk in all team associated activities.
- Manage finances of the team/squad within a set budget.
- Provide a comprehensive written report within 14 days post competition.

- Be available within 14 days post competition to conduct a formal debrief.
- Mentor up and coming team managers.
- Be responsible to manage all aspects of the team.

- Experience managing high performance/elite teams during competition.
- Experience working with high performance athletes.
- Expertise and experience in surf boat rowing competition.
- Level 2 or 3 Team Manager Course.

- Demonstrated leadership skills.
- Demonstrated ability to think strategically.
- Ability to manage/project manage.
- Highly motivated and results driven.
- Must be team orientated.
